Summer Safeguarding and Safety

The summer is here, enjoy it...

To keep safe during the summer months it's worth checking out specialised Coast and Mountain weather forecasts via the Met Office.

- The <u>Coast and Sea</u> pages give tide times, weather and UV forecasts plus links to information on lifeguarded beaches by the RNLI.
- The Mountain forecast gives detailed information on expected weather conditions for all UK mountain ranges, including the wonderful three Yorkshire Peaks.

There is a great website from the NHS here about the 5 S's of safety in the sun

- 1. slip on a t-shirt
- 2. slop on sun cream with a high protection factor
- 3. slap on a wide brimmed hat
- 4. slide on some quality sunglasses
- 5. shade from the sun wherever possible
